*** Approved Revised Conservation Review Criteria (12.5.08)**

*** Adoption of the WGCC Work Plan for 2009:**

- 1. Help in the passage of a Conservation Development ordinance**
- 2. Complete revision of the town Conservation Inventory**
- 3. Propose a local scenic/historic road plan to Town Council**
- 4. Earth Day Clean Up and related community outreach (e.g., initiate a local farmers' market; distribution of information; promote eco-community efforts, for example in the use of low-tech eco-solutions, like rain barrels, compost bins, etc.)**
- 5. Continue WGCC staff development and appropriate resources**
- 6. Continue to work with WG Land Trust on common town environmental goals and objectives**
