

ORDINANCE REGULATING MOTOR BOATS ON LAKE MISHNOCK

Passed August 8, 1973

It is hereby ordained by the Town Council of the Town of West Greenwich that:

1. No person shall operate any boat or other marine vehicle or propulsion unit on Mishnock Lake in the Town of West Greenwich, which shall be powered by any form of internal combustion engine, provided, however, that it shall be lawful to operate boats on Mishnock Lake propelled by electric motors, the power source of which is either dry cell or wet cell batteries located within the boat to be so powered.
2. No such electric-powered boat shall be operated closer than fifty (50) feet from any swimmer in said Lake.
3. Any person who operates a motor boat in violation of this ordinance shall be fined not more than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars for each offense.
4. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage.
