NO FEE ITEMS

- Stoves, Washers, Dryers, Microwaves, small appliance-put in SCRAP BIN
- E-waste which is TV's, computers, printers, and monitors- put in PODS

Do Not Put in Recycle Bin:

- NO Plastic Bags (bring these to the ReStore container at the local grocery store)
- NO Cold or Frozen Food Boxes
- NO Containers over 2 gallons (no 5 gallon pails, no laundry baskets, no plastic totes/bins, etc.*)
- NO Styrofoam
- NO Hangers, chains, pipes, or any other non-food container metal items (put in Scrap Metal Bin)
- NO Small appliances (you can donate these in the Big Sisters Bin behind the Town Hall)
- NO Christmas lights
- NO CD cases
- NO Containers that contain auto fluids (oils, antifreeze...must be taken to Eco-Depot)
- NO Plastic kids toys or plastic lawn furniture in regular bin* (these are rigid plastics)
- No oily pizza boxes or boxes with wax coating

ITEMS WE DO RECYCLE

Containers (must be smaller than 2 gallons, empty and quick-rinsed) **PLASTIC Containers** such as:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • JARS-sauce, jelly, baby food 	<p>GLASS containers:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • BOTTLES-beer, soda, wine
<p>CARTONS:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Soy milk cartons 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Milk and Juice cartons • Soup/Broth boxes, Juice boxes
<p>METAL CANS, LIDS, & FOIL:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Empty aerosol cans, hair spray, whip cream... 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Aluminum cans, <u>clean</u> foil • TIN cans- soup, beans, pet food, metal lids
<p>CLEAN PAPER & CARDBOARD:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Newspaper, magazines, phonebooks, Paperback books 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • FLATTEN Cardboard boxes • wrapping paper and tissue
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • office paper, junk mail 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cereal / granola bar boxes, paper towel rolls - all flattened

Other Recycling Services:

OIL IGLOO

We have an oil igloo on site for used motor oil and filters. See attendant for directions.

YARD WASTE

We have a bin for yard waste in paper bags and brush less than 1/2" in diameter.
